**SOUTH WEST LONDON BOWEL CANCER SCREENING PROGRAMME
ANNUAL REPORT 2010-11**

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

The SWL BCSP has been offering screening to men and women in South West London for over 4 years. During 2010/11 the South West London Bowel Screening Programme continued to deliver a good quality service to the local population.

KEY SECTIONS FOR PARTICULAR NOTE:

Screening Uptake

In 2010/11 the uptake was maintained at approximately 48% compared to the previous year, but remained below the target of 60%. Uptake in SWL was highest in Kingston (52.5%) and lowest in Wandsworth (39.9%). A good range of promotion and awareness raising activities was undertaken across SWL in various settings.

Cancer detection

In 2010/11, 64 cancers were diagnosed through the screening programme; 24 more compared to the previous year.

Age extension

Age extension was successfully introduced in SWL during early 2011. Local population aged 70-74 years are now invited for bowel cancer screening across the 5 SWL PCTs.

Quality assurance

The SWL BCSP reported one Serious Incident to the London QARC during 2010/11.

The SWL BCSC, NHS Kingston and other stakeholders continued to implement the QARC action plan during 2010/11.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

Continue to commission a high quality bowel screening service in line with national quality standards.

RISKS IDENTIFIED:

Serious untoward incidents affecting screening programmes may impact on the reputation of the PCT and damage public confidence in screening programmes. Some commissioning and funding decisions may have a similar impact.
